The composition of the Lincoln Public Library Board is determined under the authority of the current *Ontario Public Libraries Act*, in accordance with the provisions of the *Act* and of the *Regulations* made under that *Act*, and established under By-Law #2015-05 of the Town of Lincoln, approved on January 5, 2015.

By-Law #2015-05 states, in part, that:

‘[T]he Board shall be comprised of nine (9) persons appointed the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Lincoln, two (2) of whom shall be a member of the said Council and seven (7) of whom shall be citizen appointees from the community at large.’

‘[B]oard members shall hold office for a term concurrent with the term of the appointing council, or until a successor is appointed, and may be reappointed for one or more further terms.’
