



by David Baldacci



by Nancy Thayer


Scrambling through the last-minute holiday rush at her Nantucket toy shop, Christina bonds with the family of her miserly landlord, forging unexpected ties along the way.

by Lisa Jewell




A dying billionaire sends one woman and a cast of dreamers and rivals on a citywide treasure hunt.


A highly anticipated latest installment in the best-selling series finds Jack Reacher offering aid to an elderly couple only to be confronted by the most dangerous opponents of his career.



by Leigh Bardugo


