

Meeting Rooms Available

Does your group need somewhere to meet?

Lincoln Public Library has space available at both locations. Meeting rooms are provided for library and library-related programs and meetings. After these needs are met, meeting room facilities are available for use by the public.

The **Fleming Library** in Beamsville has a **study room** which seats ten and can be booked for \$10 per meeting. The fee includes the use of an interactive whiteboard. If the room is not booked, groups can use it on a drop-in basis, but the whiteboard will not be available.

The **larger meeting room** attached to the Fleming Library in the Community Complex is booked through the Town of Lincoln. Please call the Town's Community Services Department at 905.563.8205 for more details.

The **Moses F. Rittenhouse Library** in Vineland has a **meeting room** available for rent. Its capacity is 49 seated/60 standing, with six tables and 30 chairs available, plus a pull-down screen. The fee is \$20 per meeting for non-profit groups, and \$40 for all others.

Freegal offers access to about 3 million songs, including Sony Music's catalogue of legendary artists.

There is no software to download, and there are no digital rights management (DRM) restrictions. Plus you never have to return the songs!

for Holds**

Lincoln Public Library can now send you a text message when an item you have requested is available. Just let us know your cellphone number and carrier, and we'll do the rest. Or enter your information when you place the hold through our online catalogue. No spaces or dashes needed! Example: 9055637014

We can also send an e-mail when items are available, or phone you. Please note that choosing text or e-mail notification is the quickest way to find out your item is waiting for you. Calls may be delayed, depending on staffing.



Job Opportunities for High School Students

Lincoln Public Library will be hiring part-time Pages to sort and shelve library materials and do other tasks as required. Pages work about 16 to 22 hours every two weeks, after school and Saturdays, during library hours. Shifts are available at both the Moses F. Rittenhouse Library in Vineland and the Fleming Library in Beamsville.

The pay rate is \$10.30 per hour for those under the age of 18; \$11 per hour for those 18 and over.

If you are at least 14 years old (by September 8, 2014), going to high school next Fall, organized, punctual and dependable, possess excellent attention to detail, have access to reliable transportation, and are interested in libraries and library resources, we want to hear from you!
