**Stop the presses! We have ILL news!** We just heard from the Southern Ontario Library Service (SOLS) that they have worked to revise their 2019-20 budget to achieve their goal of focussing on programs that have the greatest impact to public libraries and their users.

As a result of that work, they are able to continue to give libraries access to the online system that coordinates interlibrary loans (ILL). They are not, however, able to reinstate deliveries to libraries, so we are still working on how we'll manage that. We'll let you know when we are ready to accept ILL requests, and appreciate your patience.

Also, **LiNC deliveries are back!** Once again, you can place holds on items owned by the Fort Erie, Pelham, Thorold and Niagara-on-the-Lake Public Libraries, plus Niagara College, and have them delivered to the Lincoln Public Library branch closest to you. You can also return items to an LPL branch and we'll take care of the rest.

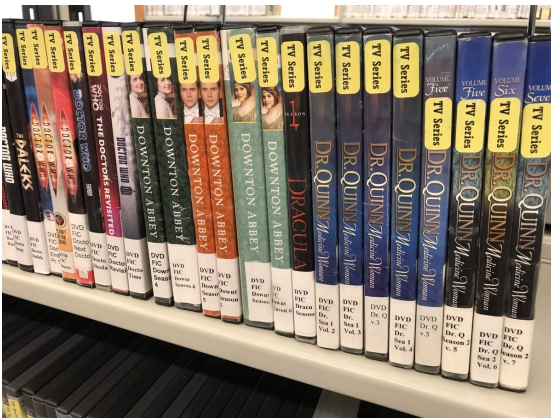




## Lincoln Public Library Honoured
