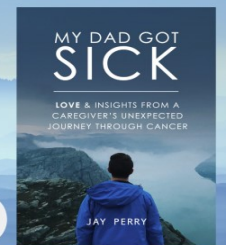
Cheers to Good Books!

A limited number of books will be available to borrow from the library. Advance registration is required. Please call 905.563.7014 to sign up.

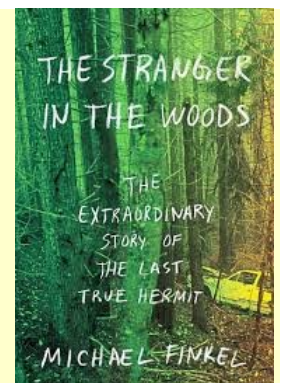
Author Talk with Jay Perry
